

AN INVITATION COMMUNITY FEEDBACK OPPORTUNITY ON THE HOLT VISION

The Holt Vision moves to its next stage. Consultation now goes back to the community with an exhibition in town from the 12th December and you are invited to give your views on the draft Vision either on a feedback form or on line to the Town Council www.holttowncouncil.org. There will also be a final public presentation in January 2012. The exhibition of the draft strategy will start at 5.00 p.m. (before the Holt Town Council meeting) in the Holt Community Centre on Monday 12th December 2011. There are a number of display boards to see and there will also be an informal presentation from the consultants and a chance to chat with them. The presentation will be given again at 6.00 p.m.

Light refreshments will be available (5.00 – 6.30 p.m.)

The exhibition will then move to Holt Library on Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th December in the mornings, before moving back to the Community Centre for the rest of that week, running beside the Community Centre's Crib Festival. The feedback from the exhibition will then be considered by the consultants and presented back to the Vision Board on 9th January 2012. There will then be a final public presentation on Thursday 19th January 2012.

The Holt Vision Board, a partnership that has been forged between private, public and community groups appointed Allies and Morrison Urban Practitioners to undertake a Vision study for the historic town of Holt in August 2011. The brief for the work includes the requirement to consult local residents, businesses and service organisations about options to:

- improve pedestrian and shopper access around key central areas
- ease traffic flows
- enable people to engage more easily with North Norfolk's training and skills development opportunities
- enhance the built environment and public realm
